

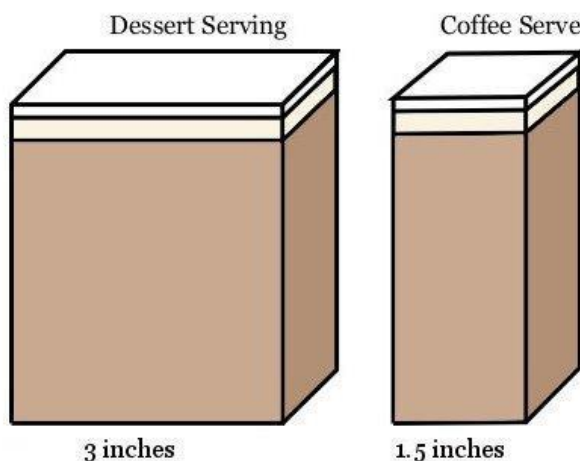
# Cake Servings Guide



The number of servings you are looking for will depend on how you wish to serve your cake.

A dessert serving is approximately 3 inches by 1 inch, and is used where the cake is to be served as a dessert.

A coffee serve is common for weddings and other functions where the cake slice is meant only as a taste, and is about 1.5 inches by 1 inch.



We have provided a table of the number of cake servings you might expect from different sized cakes. Please note that while these numbers are a useful guide, the actual number of sizes will depend on the way the cake is cut at the venue.
